Challenges in Incorporating Digital Technology in Education and Training

Psyche of the trainees to avoid online learning and shyness in using of devices, specially from the senior trainees

Scarcity of PKO training digital content in native language

Budgetary constrain as initial IT infrastructure setup for training is expensive

Lack of UN sponsored coordination and cooperation mechanism between PKTIs, T/PCCs, and UN Training and Research Institutes to derive maximum benefit from technological advancement

Recommendations

PKTIs and UN Training and Research Institutes may carry out in depth study about the future nature of UN Peacekeeping to find out future training requirement

Develop strategy to capacitate T/PCCs in terms of digital transformation

UN may consider setting up IT Infrastructure facility hubs for supporting online education and training for peacekeepers regionally

Recommendations

Digital training content for PKO in multiple languages may be developed priority being considered on the number of peacekeepers deployed

Minimum level of IT literacy benchmark for Peacekeeping deployment by T/PCC may be set by UN to encourage IT literacy and technology awareness amongst the peacekeepers

Facilitating and encouraging bi-lateral and multi-lateral online cooperation for PKO training by some central initiative under the banner of UN
