- Students can use the app to:
 - Access courses, transcripts, and their student profile
 - Download course textbooks
 - Take examinations and access
 Certificates of Completion





Course Supplements: Audiobooks and E-Publications



- Audiobook format allows students to download an audio version of the course and listen to it on their mobile phones, tablets, and computers.
- E-publications adjust to the orientation and size of a screen, making the course adaptable and easy to read on handheld devices.



Course Supplements: Interactive Modules



- POTI is researching additional course formats, including interactive modules based on existing courses.
- Interactive modules will provide further dynamic, engaging experiences for adult learners.

 e-learning to a growing audience.






