




■ Background

*KRHIS : Korea Research Institute for Human Settlements

- 2017, UN PKO Smart Camp plan was initially devised by KRIHS*.

- 2019, UN OICT* chose the Smart Camp concept.

*OICT : Office of Information and Communications Technology

- ROK 6 Pledges (Smart Camp and etc.) was presented at the 2021 Seoul UN PKM.

■ UN Mission Environment

-  **Safety** Insufficient security in the base, rudimentary CCTV surveillance
-  **Communication** Weak Internet network, price issues
-  **Transportation** Only the driving record for the vehicles noted, Limited tracking
-  **Environment** Waste management is handled poorly by local companies
-  **Energy Source** Inefficient energy and fuel sources, risk of theft and leakage



- Establish a **standard model** by reflecting UN White Paper, mission environment, requirements, technology through **ISP*** to **ROK HMEC**** in **UNMISS** until Mar 2023.

* **ISP**: Information Strategic Planning

* * **HMEC**: Horizontal Military Engineering Company

- Apply **appropriate technology** to objectives yielded from the standard model to **ROK HMEC** in **UNMISS** from 2024 to 2026.






- **Contribute 16 Helicopters (500MD)** through partnership (El Salvador & Kenya) to deploy to **UN Peacekeeping Operations (MINUSMA)**.
- UN Delegation (10PAX) visited Seoul to check the Helicopter in July 2022.
- **Transfer will be started from 2023 to 2024.**
 - * Currently detailed plan is updating with UN and Member states.

- To enhance the capacity of **engineering for peacekeepers** through the provision of **training & HEE*** to **TCC**.

* **HEE**: Heavy Engineering Equipment.

- Agreement of **TPP** between **ROK** and **Cambodia** through **UN** in **Aug 2022**.
- Planning to **Signing of the MOU** in **Nov**.
- **Provision of HEE and Training in 2023**.

* Currently detailed plan is updating with un & Cambodia MND.



- Enhance the **capacity of Medical for peacekeepers** through the provision of Medical training and supply.
- UN qualification to **ROK training Instructor**
 - 2PAX, passed the **UN BFA*** course in UK in Sep.
 - * **BFA** : Buddy First Aid
 - Participate in the **UN FMAC*** in 2023
 - * **FMAC**: Field Medical Assistant Course
- Provision of **Medical training and supply** to TCC in UN Mission in 2024. (tentatively)



- Enhance the capacity of ROK Female officer & increase participation in Mission.

- (German) UN Military Observer Course in June.
- (Mongolia) WPS Conference in June.

 - * Australia, Cambodia, Finland, India, Malaysia, Pakistan, Philippine, Sweden, United Kingdom, Vietnam.




- **PKO Memorandum of Understanding**

 - Publish a reports of contingent, SO & MO.


